The tune "St. Patrick," an Irish melody arranged by Charles Villiers Stanford in 1902, is combined with a second tune of Celtic origin, "Deirdre," which was harmonized by Ralph Vaughan-Williams. The postlude is Roberta Rowland-Raybold's 2018 setting of the tune "Lasst uns erfreuen," which has been inspiring composers and arrangers ever since it was first published in a German hymnal in 1623.
